

# Entrelac-A-Long (knit) STEP ONE



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## **STEP ONE:**

### **Materials:**

NEEDLES: Size US 8 DPNs, two 24" circular needles for two circulars technique, or one 32" or longer circular needle for Magic Loop technique.

YARN: Self-striping worsted weight (about 100g) OR 2 balls of contrasting color

GAUGE: 20 sts and 16 rows = 4" in stockinette

**Cast on** 80 sts (for 21 ½" head circumference) using preferred cast on method. Join being careful not to twist.

### **Ribbing:**

Round 1: K2, P2 all the way around.

Round 2: Repeat round 1.

Continue for 8 more rounds.

Round 10: Add 4 stitches evenly around. That is,  
\*(K2, P2) 5 times, M1, repeat from \* around.

### **ROUND ONE: Get ready for entrelac.**

Knit base triangles, as follows:

\*\*Knit 2, turn

Purl 2, turn

Knit 3, turn

Purl 3, turn

Knit 4 turn

Purl 4, turn

Knit 5, turn

Purl 5, turn

Knit 6, \*\*

Repeat from \*\* to \*\* around.



(Yes, that is correct. We go from K6 right into the next K2...but it is better to think of this way, rather than saying K8, so it is clear you have completed one triangle and are beginning another. Really.)

If you did this correctly, you will now have 14 base triangles made.
